KIP FENN – REFLECTIONS

Kip Fenn's life was affected deeply by many of the major themes of the last century: the rich/poor divide, pornography/internet regulation, climate change, endemic social terrorism, the Pearly Way/euthanasia, cloning, the Jihad Wars and the Grey Years.
